

ORGANISING A WRITTEN RESPONSE TO TEXT

About this resource

This framework could be used for a number of different written responses and different subjects. It prompts the learner to think carefully about each sentence and supportive evidence. Breaking it down into smaller chunks allows students to build their answer rather than face the dreaded blank page.

Use this framework to support a written response to a piece of text and structure an essay.
